


IS THERE ANY **V ABOUT** WORLD WAS THE WORLD?

THE TEAM

DELPHINE PERRET

A graduate of the École Supérieure des Arts Décoratifs de Strasbourg, Delphine Perret has been working for the publisher as a writer and illustrator since 2003. She has published approximately forty books, mainly with *Éditions Les Fourmis Rouges*. These have been translated into ten languages and have received awards, including from the Salon du Livre et de la Presse Jeunesse de Montreuil (SLPJ), the Geneva Book Fair, Libbylit (Belgium) and the Association des Librairies Spécialisés Jeunesse.

Her work, which is often minimalist, explores the relationships between text and images, narration and efficient drawing. She also writes for other illustrators and is involved in genres other than literature, creating mural paintings, live drawings and music playback sessions.







MARC LACOURT

Marc Lacourt trained as a sports education professional, obtaining a Bachelor's Degree in Science and Techniques Applied to Physical and Sporting Activities (STAPS for its French initials). His career in choreography developed with the help of choreographers Toméo Vergès, Pierre-Johan Suc / Magali Pobel (Androphyne Company), and Laurent Falgueiras. Since 2012, he has been dancing for Ambra Senatore (playing John and 'Un Terzo' in particular), with whom he also collaborates, co-writing both Giro di Pista (2018) and Il nous faudrait un secrétaire [We Need a Secretary] (2020). In parallel to his experience as a dancer, he enjoys taking place in a number of workshops for children and teenagers at primary and secondary schools as well as art schools. In 2016, he created his first work destined for a young audience, Tiondeposicom, followed by La Serpillère de Monsieur Mutt [Mr Mutt's Mop] in 2019.

PAULINE VALENTIN

Who is Pauline at MA Compagnie? She is a dancer and comedian who showed up one Monday in February 2018 to work as the stage manager of an MA Compagnie show in the company's very beginnings. Since then, she has added 'Mop Manager' to the top of her resume, and by adding *Why is a tree a chicken*?, she plans to grow that same resume to include 'professional lever interpreter and electromagnetic tinkerer'. She loves working for and with children and feels at home with Marc's artistic approach and the human relationships that he creates; that is why she travels so many kilometres with him by truck.
